The aim is to install energy generating assets:

- owned by the community,
- supplying energy direct to the community and
- providing surplus income that can be used to fund on-going energy efficient improvements.

Creation of a community woodland to absorb residual emissions and provide wood for village use could be an additional element of the scheme.
