CHRISTMAS BONUS FOR TREE-PLANTING

A £2000 grant has been awarded to Barningham Net Zero for our tree planting project to improve the environment, support wildlife and enhance biodiversity. The work also contributes to our action plan to counter global warming carbon emissions by taking local action to increase carbon sinks. The grant from the Postcode Local Trust, funded entirely by players of the People's Postcode Lottery, supplements the support we are already receiving from Trees for Teesdale. It will enable us to purchase some fruit trees to complement the mixed deciduous tree and hedge species that comprise most of our planting.

We've already tested out our thermals and waterproofs and trained some new volunteers at our pre-Christmas sessions at three sites. Should you wish to join a working party after the holidays, please contact Martha (07984 756080). We will be running weekly sessions, about 2 hour's duration, from January to March at sites in Barningham and Newsham. *Note: these are run as small groups with strict social distancing.*

To date we have planted over 200 trees: 24 in enclosures and the remainder used to create a new copse. The species planted so far include Aspen, Beech, Bird Cherry, Birch (Silver and Hairy), Dogwood, Hazel, Hornbeam, Horse Chestnut, Oak (English and Sessile) and Sycamore, plus 7 apple trees and a green gage.

Many thanks to the land owners for allowing us to work on their land, our volunteers for their hard work so far, and well-wishers in the community who have donated trees and tree guards!
